On April 21st, the day after Easter, Pope Francis died. We are not Roman Catholic and we don't necessarily follow the leadership of the Pope, but many Lutherans had great affection for Pope Francis. He was considered a Pope of the people, emphasizing a simpler lifestyle and care for the poor

as central to what we are called to as Christians. This resonated not only with many Catholics and Lutherans, but with people all around the world, Christians and non-Christians alike.

Because of this, Pope Francis leaves a legacy. He brought the church together. You may not have liked everything that he did or taught. You may not have paid any attention to him at all. It is possible that you had hoped he would go further or make changes that he wasn't ready to make. But this Pope, more than any other in modern times showed us how to see Christ in our neighbor and challenged us to consider what it looks like to serve.

There is now a new uncertainty in the Roman church as people wonder who will be chosen as the new Pope. Questions arise about how that person will lead, what their priorities will be, and how they will represent the church in a political world. Each Pope is different, but the legacy left by Pope Francis will no doubt have influence over future leaders. The way he embodied the gospel will be a call to faithfulness for new leadership and for all people even now that he is gone. Please pray for our siblings in the Roman Catholic Church as they transition to new leadership. And while you are at it, pray for our own denomination was we elect a new Presiding Bishop this summer. In this Easter season of new life, pray that God will inspire and renew the church in all of its expressions, that the Holy Spirit would unite us, and that the good news of Jesus Christ would be apparent in the way that all of us live.


